

RESOLUTION #645

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE ALASKA STATE LEGISLATURE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,343,500 FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1991

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel seeks to develop basic infrastructure in an effort to support economic development within the community and region; and

WHEREAS, basic water, sewer and solid waste systems are severely inadequate to meet existing state and federal minimum standards; the local roads present a clear hazard to public safety; and municipal services and programs are scattered throughout the community creating a financial burden and reducing level of program service delivery; and

WHEREAS, the City must insure for the life and health safety of the public; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel lacks the financial resources to accomplish these goals.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council establishes the following projects in priority for the City of Bethel Fiscal Year 1991 Capital Improvement Program request to the Governor and Alaska State Legislature:
