

October Meeting 1960

Meeting was called to order by Dr. Jackson at 8:00 pm. Roll was called by Ben Smit--Don Shantz, Clyde Hall, Rev. Gable, Dr. Jackson, Ben Smit, were present. Elliott and Miller were absent.

Smit moved that Lillian Jung be temporary secretary at \$2.00 a hour, seconded by Shantz, all ayes-non opposed.

The minutes of the Sept. 12 meeting were read by Ben Smit--one correction was made by Dr. Jackson--minutes were then accepted.

A letter from the sec. of state was read by Smit. A suggestion was made by Lillie Schmidt that the council get personalized checks made.

Shantz moved that the city pay employers contribution for Public works Fund Employees out of general fund. Ben seconded all ayes none opposed.

Communications were then read.

Smit proposed that we publicize the harbor situation--he will write the nec. letters.

Smit moved that Mrs. Crane be reimbursed \$10.38 for the Borough Committee Shantz seconded--all ayes-none opposed.

Smit to get a Dunn and Bradstreet report on telephone and also write the accountant for reports.

Dr. Jackson read the police reports--discussion on typewriter for police dept. Shantz moved the city purchase a typewriter with a 14 inch carriage for the cities use. Gamble seconded--all ayes- none opposed.

Ben moved that the policeman be authorized to find and employ on a trial basis an auxiliary policeman at \$20 .00 per day once a week, whose appointment is to be presented at the next meeting. Seconded by Shantz--all ayes -none opposed.

Gamble moved that the police committee be disband--Hall seconded--all ayes.

Smit moved we continue the meeting for another 30 minutes--Shantz seconded--all ayes.

Smit read the ordinance #12 amendment to sales taxes. Shantz moved that it should be posted as the first reading & 2nd reading will be at the next meeting. Copies are to be posted in town. Seconded by Ben all ayes-none opposed.

Shantz moved that we order tank and garbage rack for Sanitation truck from Anc. should the cost not exceed \$1000.00 and it be shipped out via Air National Guard free of charge if possible. Seconded by Ben all ayes. Ben moved Shantz be authorized to hire workers to dig out the bed unbolt it and bring it to town seconded by Hall --all ayes--none opposed.

Gamble moved we employ Sarge Connick in accordance with the public works and that the city select workmen to assist him. Shantz seconded--all ayes. Shantz moved the meeting be closed--Hall seconded all ayes--none opposed.
