RESOLUTION #95-47

A RESOLUTION OF THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL REQUESTING CAPITAL FUNDING THROUGH THE STATE OF ALASKA VILLAGE SAFE WATER PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City Council is the governing body of the City of Bethel; and

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes that the health and safety of the residents of Bethel depend upon improved sanitation systems, and desires that these facilities be provided for the residents of Bethel; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation/Village Safe Water Program can provide the financial assistance necessary to improve the sanitation systems.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that the following water and sewer projects are identified as the City of Bethel's priority list for funding requests through the Village Safe Water Program:


1. Original Townsite Piped Water and Sewer System Construction	\$ 2,000,000
2. City Subdivision Piped Water and Sewer System Construction	6,500,000
3. Water and Sewer Extension to 40 HUD Units	1,000,000
TOTAL COSTS	\$ 9,500,000

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby instructed to advise the Governor, Legislature and Department of Environmental Conservation of the projects supported by the City for the Fiscal Year 1996-97, and to take all appropriate steps to provide the necessary background information.
