

ORDINANCE 173

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, ESTABLISHING THE PHILLIPS ALCOHOLISM TREATMENT CENTER ADVISORY BOARD.

THE BETHEL MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES IS HEREBY AMENDED TO ADD THE FOLLOWING CHAPTER AND SECTIONS:

CHAPTER 2.30 PHILLIPS ALCOHOLISM TREATMENT CENTER ADVISORY BOARD

SECTION 2.30.010 ESTABLISHED; COMPOSITION; TERMS OF MEMBERS; QUALIFICATIONS; QUORUM; MEETINGS.

- (a) There is established a Phillips Alcoholism Treatment Center Advisory Board consisting of nine members appointed for overlapping two-year terms commencing on the first day of the fiscal year of the City of Bethel. The City Council shall appoint the members of the Board. The first Board shall consist of four members appointed for a term of one year and five members appointed for a term of two-years. Successors to the members of the first Board shall be appointed for two-year terms.
- (b) All members of the Board shall be residents of the City of Bethel during the term of their appointment. One member of the Board shall be an elected member of the Bethel City Council.
- (c) Five members of the Board constitute a quorum for the conduct of business. The Board shall meet at least once each month and at such other times either as directed by the City Council or in accordance with special meeting procedures established by the Board.
- (d) The City Council may declare a vacancy on the Board following a resignation accepted by the Board, a failure of any member of the Board to qualify or continue to qualify with the eligibility requirements of statutes and ordinances, or upon a reasonable declaration of expulsion or vacancy by a two-thirds majority of the Board.

SECTION 2.30.020 POWERS AND DUTIES

- (a) The Board shall conduct studies and analyses to insure the proper administration and operation of PATC in a manner that will protect the public health, safety, and welfare and promote efficient and effective cultural alcohol education and alcohol treatment.
- (b) The Board shall promulgate rules and regulations for the orderly and efficient conduct of its meetings.


- (c) The Board shall submit to the City Council before the end of each fiscal year a report including an analysis and evaluation of current fiscal year programs, including recommendations regarding program goals for the next fiscal year.
