Miller reported that Hoffman would contract with the city at \$12 an hour to for 12 hours to clean up the garbage dump with his cat. Miller moved that the contract be made with Hoffman as proposed. Christiansen seconded. 4 eyes. 0 nays.

Shantz discussed the new National Guard Armory to be constructed. He estimated flooring, hardwood, would run about \$3000.00 and that labor to install the same would amount to \$2000.00.

Much discussion was held. Miller said that the school should really be the ones to finance the flooring. Shantz said that he still had not heard from Mr. Skeen about the school plans. Shantz assured the Council that the gym would be open for town use 5 nights a week.

Christiansen moved that all possibilities be looked into whereby the flooring might be financed, then if there were no other way or no one else to pay that the City Council offer \$3500.00 for the flooring project. Miller seconded. Vote-Anvil-yes

Dr. Jackson suggested that Miller and Shantz see Mr. Weiss to ask him to be the city spokesman to look into other possibilities.
