

ORDINANCE 158

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA ESTABLISHING AND SETTING FORTH THE ORGANIZATION AND DUTIES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY SERVICES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, HEREBY ORDAINS THAT THE BETHEL CODE OF ORDINANCES BE AMENDED TO INCLUDE A NEW CHAPTER, CHAPTER 2.28, ENTITLED "DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY SERVICES",

SECTION ONE; Title 2 of the Bethel Code of Ordinances is amended by addition of a new Chapter 2.28 to read as follows:

Chapter 2.28

DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY SERVICES 2.28.010 Established. There is established a Department of Community Services.

2.28.020 Functions. The functions of the Department of Community Services shall include:

- a. Identifying existing and future recreation demands including indoor and outdoor recreation and community services.
- b. Evaluating existing and future recreation and community service needs.
- c. Generating priorities and action plans including a capital improvement program for parks, recreation and community service facilities.
- d. Reviewing and recommending revisions as necessary to recreation and community service facilities.

2.28.030 Functions. The functions of the Department of Community Services shall include:

- a. Developing, planning and coordinating a system of parks, play grounds, and recreation facilities, and establishing optimum use potential of existing recreation facilities.

- b. Developing and implementing a comprehensive recreational program for the City of Bethel including diversified programs that include a variety of age ranges and interests.
- c. Such other related functions as the City Manager and Council may assign.

2.28.040 Supervision. The Department of Community Services shall be headed by the Community Services Director.

- a. The Community Services Director shall hire and supervise the Department's employees and manage the Department subject to the City Manager's authorization and consent.

SECTION TWO: This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage.
