A Resolution Requesting The Alaska State Legislature Adequately Fund A Full Gymnasium At The New Kilbuck School In Bethel

- WHEREAS**, the City of Bethel, Alaska is desirous of having adequate, safe, family friendly facilities for the young people of the City of Bethel;
- WHEREAS**, the State of Alaska has allocated funds for the replacement of the existing Kilbuck elementary school;
- WHEREAS**, it is incumbent upon the City to lend support and assist where the Lower Kuskokwim School District in its efforts to adequately provide for the students enrolled in Kilbuck School;
- WHEREAS**, an indoor recreational facility is important and essential for the health safety and welfare of the young citizens of Bethel in order to provide a safe environment for physical recreation;
- WHEREAS**, a full sized gymnasium at the new school will help meet the needs of the students and the community to provide for in-school and after hours recreational opportunities.


