A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA,
REQUESTING FINANCIAL SUPPORT FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA
FOR THE HEPATITIS "B" IMMUNIZATION PROGRAM.


WHEREAS, over the past several years the Yukon-Kuskokwim
Delta has had a high incidence of Hepatitis "B";
and

WHEREAS, Bethel, as the service center for the Yukon-
Kuskokwim Delta recognizes the urgency of
implementing a Hepatitis "B" immunization
program; and

WHEREAS, financial support to combat the problem is
required not only to conduct the appropriate
tests and provide vaccine, but also to provide
funds for area wide health education directed
at prevention of the spread of Hepatitis "B",

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of
Bethel, Alaska, on behalf of the residents of Bethel
and the Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta, urges the State of Alaska
to support the Hepatitis "B" immunization program for
the Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta.
