


An Ordinance Prohibiting the Creation of a Risk of Harm Upon a Roadway and Providing Punishment Therefore.

Section A. No person shall cross or be upon the traveled portion of a highway; street; road; alleyway; or public boardwalk, slough area, or paths or trails within the City of Bethel's jurisdictional boundaries and conduct himself in a manner which creates substantial and unjustifiable risk of harm to himself, others, or to property. A substantial and unjustifiable risk is a risk of such a nature and degree that the conscious disregard of it or failure to perceive it constitutes a major deviation from the standard of conduct that a reasonable person would observe in the situation.

Section B. Upon conviction, a person guilty of creating such a risk is punishable by a fine of not more than \$100.00. In no event shall any fine less than \$25.00 be imposed and such fine shall not be suspended, nor may the punishment provided in this Section be reduced under A.S. 11.05.105.


