

RESOLUTION #93-31

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, REQUESTING FUNDING FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION VILLAGE SAFE WATER PROGRAM AND SUPPORTING THEIR EFFORTS TO OBTAIN FUNDING FOR WATER AND SEWER PROJECTS IN THE CITY OF BETHEL.

WHEREAS, efficient and reliable water and sewer systems is one of the most important responsibilities of federal, state and local governments and the City of Bethel has determined water and sewer projects to be the number one priority for Capital Improvement Projects; and

WHEREAS, the health and safety of the residents of Bethel depend upon improved sanitation systems; and


WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation is responsible for long-range statewide planning of such projects;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bethel, Alaska, that the following water and sewer projects are identified as the City of Bethel's priority list for funding requests through Village Safe Water Program:

1.	Sewer Lagoon Construction Sewer lagoon grading, dressing 1993-94 construction, design completion	\$ 500,000
2.	City Subdivision Final Design with Well and WTP 1994-95 Construction	5,000,000
3.	Kilbuck and Main Wastewater Lift Stations 1994 Construction and Design Completion	50,000
4.	Bethel Heights Western Addition No.1/Tundra North Water and Sewer Project	25,000
5.	Original Townsite Preliminary Design	150,000
	Total Costs	\$ 5,725,000

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby instructed to advise the Governor, Legislature and Department of Environmental Conservation of the projects supported by the City for the Fiscal Year 1995 and to take all appropriate steps to provide the necessary background information.
