A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE ORUTSARARMIUT NATIVE CORPORATION IN ITS PREPARATION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE U.S. DEPT. OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES TO FUND INCREASED AND ENHANCED SENIOR SERVICES IN BETHEL

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Administration on Aging, has funds available under the Older Americans Act, Title VI, Part A—Grants for Native Americans and Part C—Grants for the Native American Caregiver Support Program;

WHEREAS, current funding levels range from \$73,620 to \$179,990 for Title VI, Part A and from \$16,990 to \$67,990 for Title VI, Part C;

WHEREAS, the purpose of these Title VI grants is to provide nutritional and supportive services to American Indian or Alaska Native elders under Part A and to provide Family Caregiver support services under Part C;

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel's Senior Services Department, which currently provides nutritional and supportive services to Alaska Native elders, will be able to increase its services with additional funding made possible through this grant;

WHEREAS, the Senior Services Department recognizes a community need to offer Family Caregiver support services and will be able to do so with additional funding made possible through this grant;

WHEREAS, the Senior Services Center and respective service delivery responsibility will be transferred from the City of Bethel to the Orutsararmiut Native Council on July 1, 2005;

WHEREAS, the Orutsararmiut Native Council will work with the City of Bethel to prepare a grant application to pursue funding under the Older Americans Act, Title VI, Part A and Part C. to benefit senior citizens in Bethel;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council supports the Orutsararmiut Native Council in its preparation and submission of a Title VI grant application on behalf of Bethel's senior citizens.
