RESOLUTION #93-26

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, ACCEPTING AN AMENDMENT TO VILLAGE SAFE WATER GRANT #16711 FOR THE CITY SUBDIVISION PIPED WATER SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel requested an appropriation from the 1992 Alaska State Legislature through the Village Safe Water Program toward the design and construction of a piped water system for City Subdivision, and

WHEREAS, the Alaska State Legislature made an appropriation in the amount of \$200,000 for this project, and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel requested from the 1993 Alaska State Legislature an amendment to the HB 165 appropriation to include the design and construction of a sewer system for City Subdivision, and

WHEREAS, during the 1993 legislative session the Alaska State Legislature passed the amendment and added the words *and sewer* to the appropriation contained in HB 165; and

WHEREAS, all remaining general grant conditions remain in effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Bethel City Council that it hereby accepts the amendment to Grant Number 16711 for \$200,000 for the design and construction of a piped water and sewer system for City Subdivision, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to sign all grant documents and administer the grant in accordance with its conditions on behalf of the City.
