

RESOLUTION 439

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, APPOINTING FROM THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF BETHEL ELECTION JUDGES FOR PRECINCTS ONE, TWO AND THREE FOR THE OCTOBER 2, 1984 ELECTION.

WHEREAS, the duty of the City Council, pursuant to Section 2.44.100 of Chapter 2.4 (Elections) of the Bethel Code of Ordinances, is to appoint from the qualified electors of the City of Bethel, at least three (3) but not more than five (5) judges of election in each precinct at a regular or special meeting of the City Council held at least seven (7) days prior to the date of the election; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is required by the aforesaid Section of the Bethel Code of Ordinances to designate one (1) judge in each precinct to serve as Chairperson of the judges appointed for that precinct and to constitute all judges selected as the Board of Election for the General Election to be held on October 2, 1984,
