## REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING May 25, 1970

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Dave Swanson. Roll was called. Present; Jack Baxter, Bruce Crow, Eddie Hoffman, Kevin Murphy, Robert Nick, Gene Peltola, Dave Swanson.

Absent: None.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

**COMMUNICATIONS:** Snodgrass read the following letters; 1) from the United States Department of Interior, Bureau of Land Management to the City regarding the Statement of Real Property ownership, 2) State of Alaska, Dept. of Education regarding the city library, 3) Federal Field Committee, on possible uses of the Multipurpose Community Center and Training Facility, 4) from Crittenden etc. on Neighborhood Facility.

**COMPLAINTS AND PEOPLE TO BE HEARD:** Gene Stone complaint about trash in front of the Day Care Center.

**TREASURERS REPORT:** Report was given for the month of April 1970.

**ADMINISTRATORS REPORT:** Snodgrass reported that the radio station proposals were now on the Senators desk.

**MAYORS COMMENTS:** Dave Swanson reported that Jack Faulkner was hired as Bethel city recreation director. He also stated that 10 applications have been received. Only two have been interviewed in Anchorage.

**REPORT OF STANDING COMMITTEES:** Studnek Roads, the committee wanted to know the estimate cost of the road repairs.

**OLD BUSINESS:** Jail Guard Pay Raise and Crows Fish Pier, no action taken.

**NEW BUSINESS:** The old Quonset, Neighborhood Facilities and Liquor Store to be placed on the agenda. Unanimous.

M/M Crow, Peltola to give Snodgrass the authority to negotiate with HUD for an additional of \$50,000.00.

Poll vote: Peltola yes, Baxter yes, Crow yes, Swanson yes, Murphy yes, Nick yes, Hoffman yes.

**Liquor Store:** M/M Crow, Baxter to accept the offer of \$1.00 from Northern Commercial and instruct the administrator to begin the legal procedures.
