ORDINANCE #01-26

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5.20.160 OF THE BETHEL
MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING PAYMENT OF FEES FOR REGULATION
OF TAXICABS AND RIVER TAXIS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is permanent in nature and shall be placed in the Bethel Municipal Code.

Section 2. Amendment of Section 5.20.160. Section 5.20.160 of the Bethel Municipal Code is amended to read as follows (new language underlined and old language stricken out):

5.20.160 Fees.

The following fees shall be payable to the City of Bethel:

A. \$150.00 monthly shall be paid to the Transportation Inspector for the issuance or renewal of a bus, limousine, dispatch service, or taxicab permit no later than the 10th of each month.

B. \$125.00 annually shall be paid to the Transportation Inspector for the initial issuance and each annual renewal of a chauffeur's license no later than the 10th day of December each year.

C. \$125.00 monthly shall be paid to the Transportation Inspector for the issuance or renewal of a river taxi permit no later than the 10th of each month.

D. \$100.00 shall be paid to the City Clerk for each appeal from a decision of the Transportation Inspector to the Commission under Chapters 5.20 through 5.50. Such fee shall be refunded if the decision is subsequently reversed. The City Clerk must notify all Commission members when an appeal is filed. The fee shall be forfeited if the party making the appeal fails to show for the appeal hearing.

E. \$85.00 shall be paid to the Transportation Inspector each time that a taxicab permittee applies to substitute a vehicle that operates under a permit.


F. \$125.00 shall be paid to the Transportation Inspector for an application to transfer an interest in a taxicab permit in accordance with the provisions of Chapters 5.20 through 5.50.

G. There shall be a \$100.00 surcharge for late payment of fees provided for in subsections A, B, and C of this section 5.20.160.


Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately.
