

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA,
PLACING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A CITY UTILITY MAINTENANCE SHOP ON
THE MARCH 23, 1982 SPECIAL ELECTION BALLOT.

WHEREAS, the population of Bethel, Alaska, continues to grow
thereby placing an ever increasing demand on the City's
Utility Services Department; and

WHEREAS, the existing Public Utility Maintenance Facility is
inadequate to meet the present needs of the population
of Bethel thereby making it extremely difficult to meet
the demand of the projected growth in population for
the City of Bethel; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has done considerable planning for
the construction of a new Public Utility Maintenance
Facility that will meet current demand and have the
capability for future expansion to meet the demand of
Bethel's growing population,


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City
