SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING

JULY 1, 1968

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Arthur Nicholson.

Present: J.B. Haroldson, Ed Hoffman, Al Laroux, Arthur Nicholson, David Swanson

Absent: Bruce Crow, Art Dull

The preliminaries were dispensed with and the council went on to discuss old and new business.

OLD BUSINESS

City Policeman

David Swanson gave a report on the Police Contract and correspondence with the Department of Public Safety. Mr. Personnet said they would give a thirty day extension and aid the city in finding a qualified City Policeman.

M/M Swanson, J.B. Haroldson that we request from the Department of Public Safety, a verbal extension of the police contract from 30 to 60 days and their assistance in helping the city locate a qualified man to take the position of the city policeman and at the same time request a meeting with the Governor the Department of Public Safety and the Youth & Adult Authority with two city representatives preferably in Anchorage or Juneau if necessary.

Passed Unanimously 5 ayes and 0 nos.

VEHICLE MAINTENANCE

M/M Nicholson that a letter written terminating this present contract and request that parts belonging to the city be returned to the City Administrator at the City Office, and the contract be put up for bid at the earliest date possible.

LOG BUILDING


ASCAP has informed the city that they do not want the building now. Discussion was held on what to do with the building and the possibility of using it for the City Office.

SAND PIT

SANITATION ACCOUNTS

Ed Hoffman was asked by the Mayor to determine who could or couldn't pay their bill. It was decided the ones who could pay would be given 10 day notice.

RESOLUTION 48

Resolution 48 was placed into its first reading by Mayor Nicholson
M/M Nicholson, Swanson that the City Administrator be appointed to represent the City of Bethel in negotiations with the Public Health Service concerning sanitation and water supply. Passed

M/M Swanson, Haroldsen that Resolution 48 be accepted in its first reading and put into its second reading by title only.

Resolution 48 passed.


M/M Swanson, Hoffman that the Council proceed beyond 10 PM Passed unanimously


BUDGET
