Shantz moved that Council President be authorized to negotiate for services of Earl Couthart not to exceed \$600.00 to take down and put up the City Building located at 3rd & Main and to include cost of labor but not materials for the following:

1. 16" roll type insulation on walls & ceiling
2. visqueen on walls & ceiling
3. 1/4" plywood on walls & Ceiling
4. Lower ceiling to allow for 9' clearance
5. Lower doors to allow for 8' clearance

Also included in the motion:

1. Purchase 3 timbers measuring 6" X 12" X 28' from Eddie Hoffman at total price of \$90.00
2. Have fill hauled into the area with limitation of \$500.00
3. That Donald Baker be used and paid same figure as foreman in revamping the City Building
4. To purchase necessary local materials to complete the job.
5. Provide for minimum Wiring, 12-2 romax
