

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 18 ;
BY REPEALING AND RE-ENACTING SECTIONS 6 and
7; and PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DAT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE OCUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA:

Section 1. Repealer. Sections 6 and 7 of Ordinance No. 18
are
are hereby repealed.

Section 2. Re-enacting. Sections 6 and 7 or Ordinance No. 18
are hereby re-enacted into law as follows:

Section 6. DOGS RUNNING AT LARGE; POLICE - In the event
a dog pound is not maintained, it shall be the duty of the
Police Department of the City of Bethel to issue a summons
to any owner who allows his dog or dogs to run at large in
the City of Bethel, in violation of this ordinance. Summons
may be issued without prior notification to restrain said dog.

Section 7. The owner who has allowed his dog to run at large
shall be fined in a sum not to exceed \$25.00 and not less than
\$10.00.

If, after a hearing, the owner of a dog continues to allow his
dog to run at large, the dog shall be destroyed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon
passage and approval.
