

MINUTES OF THE BETHEL VILLAGE COUNCIL  
MAY 4, 1959 N.C THEATER 8 P.M.

Meeting opened by Robert Carpenter at 15 to nine. Council members present. Robert Carpenter, Ben Smit, Howard Elliot, Nora Guinn. others 8

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved. Treasurers report Bank balance \$12,437.89.

Finance report by Smit. Ledger, bank balance in order

Mr Carpenter reported Dept of Health requested easment. Carpenter talked to them over phone and stated we were not in position to give ease-ment. Elliot stated Hoffman was to see the Bureau of Public roads in Juneau, and Representative Hoffman suggested we give him a copy of the priority of roads we want in. This will comply with the set sent in by the Chamber of Commerce. Discussion on Airstrip. Council previously written in to Dept of Aviation requesting field be kept open for a period of 1 year. Letter to Dept of Aviation read, also answer.

WRITE to Dept of Aviation stating very likely an individual would sub-lease airstrip but this Council does not feel we have any right to give lease, how to get clear title, policy on equipment.

Pierson stated 1958 licenses void. There will be \$50.00 fine on persons caught with old plates as there has been enough time to procure them. Smit reports oje Street light arrived all but one part. Will order balance by parcel post.

Smit moved Council matches funds with Chamber of Commerce up ~~100~~ to \$100.00 on Clean up Campaign Elliot seconded. 4 ayes 0 nays.

Motion carried.

Latrine which Chamber of Commerce turned over to Village will be looked into and brought up at the next meeting.

Rules of Procedure for Council Read. Will hold before voting on extra Councilmembers.

Filtration plant as means of water supply brought up. Write Arington asking what plant to get, capacity needed, and all pertinent specs on type and size for Bethel.

WRITE Deligate Bartlet to inquire to Army surplus to locate water filtration plant, after we hear from Arington.

Elliot moved meeting be adjourned. Smit seconded. 4 ayes 0 nays Meeting adjourned.
