## Minutes of the City Council Meeting

November 19, 1962

At the National Guard Armory

Present: Swanson, Gamble, Weise, E. Hoffman, J. Hoffman, Watkins, Shantz

Minutes of the October 8th meeting were read and approved.

Minutes of the October 15th meeting were read.

MMS Gamble/Shantz to change rule No. 2 under jail visiting rules to read "Visitors must be a member of the prisoner's immediate family, a minister, or a person with legitimate business to transact with prisoner that can not wait until he is released. MC

Minutes were then approved as read.

The minutes of the November 3th meeting were read and approved as read.

MMS Gamble/Shantz to purchase a set of "Alaska Statutes" for use by the City Policeman, and also to write to the State department for two copies of the Alaska State Police manual. E. Hoffman, J. Hoffman, Watkins, Shantz, Gamble in favor Weise opposed.

MMS Shantz/J. Hoffman that we accept the work done on the sewage truck on the basis that workmanship be guaranteed for a period of 30 operating days from date of acceptance by contractor. MC

MMS Shantz/ E. Hoffman to send the \$200.00 to the Bureau of Land Management as a deposit to cover expenses involved in Townsite addition. E. Hoffman, J. Hoffman, Watkins, Weise, Shantz, Gamble in favor.

The Chairman appointed Jack E. Weise, John Samuelson, Adolph Lind, and Nora Guinn to act as witnesses to the posting of trustee's Notice of Entry etc.

A new ordinance concerning traffic regulations was referred back to the Police Committee, for study, to hold a public hearing and to present back to the Council at a later date.

MMS Shantz/Gamble To replenish the Policeman's petty Cash fund in the amount of \$35.03. J.H. Hoffman, E. Hoffman, Watkins, Weise, Shantz, Gamble in favor.

MMS Shantz/Weise to expend \$15.00 to have someone paint the Magistrates office. Hoffman, E. Hoffman, Shantz, Weise, Watkins, Gamble in favor.

The Secretary is to write to the Fairbanks insurance Agency in regards to coverage for Arthur Nicholson's water truck when used as a Fire truck, and in regards to volunteer firemen going to the scene in their own vehicle.

The Secretary is to write to Mr. McNealy in regards, to payments made to the volunteer firemen. i.e. should checks returned by firemen be placed in general fund, should taxes be deducted from checks, also is fireman protected by the

insurance policy if he should do damage to a building, which the owner though unnecessary, in his line of duty as a fireman.

MMS Weise/Shantz to repost bids for the moving and repairing of fire house, with bidder, bidding on any part or parts or he may bid on the whole. All bids to be in on December 3rd, with bids being opened and awarded on that date. MC

MMS Weise/Watkins to recess for two minutes. MC

MMS Weise/Gamble to continue with the order of business as necessary. MC

MMS Shantz/Weise to appropriate the sum of \$609.07 for the Stage for Armory, \$200.00 of which may be reimbursed by the school to the City. Gamble, Weise Watkins, Shantz, Ed. Hoffman, J. Hoffman in favor.

MMS Shantz/Gamble to pay bills of Hedla and Sherwood (760.00) Tundra Telephone Co. (\$227.00) and to the Bethel School (\$300.00) due on Bleachers. Gamble, Weise, Watkins, Shantz, E. Hoffman, J. Hoffman in favor.

To write to Mr. McNealy to find out procedure of applying for a Club Liquor License.

MMS Weise/Shantz. the chair appoint a committee of 5 to meet with Mr. Vician to plan a program for name the school. MC Members to be appointed at a later date.

MMS Shantz/Weise to have the sewage truck contractor to connect exhaust to tank of Sewage truck, cost not to exceed \$25.00. Gamble Weise, Watkins, Shantz, E. Hoffman, J. Hoffman in favor.

Committee Appointments : Police Gamble; Fire-Shantz; Road-J.Hoffman, E. Hoffman; Sewage-Watkins; Park & Recreation-Swanson; Rivers & Harbors-Weise. Each Committee head then is to select his committee members.

MMS Shantz/Weise. to table any discussion of tidelands. MC

Hoffman/Shantz that Ordinance No. 20 be accepted as read and be placed in second reading by title only. MC. Ordinance No. 20 was read by title only and was placed in third and final reading by title only. J. Hoffman, E. Hoffman, Shantz, Watkins and Gamble in favor. Weise opposed.

MMS Gamble/E. Hoffman accept the lowest of the two bids for jail supplies. J. Hoffman, J. Hoffman, Shantz, wankins, Weise and Gamble in favor.

MMS Watkins/Shantz to accept the lowest bid for prisoners meals Hoffman, Hoffman Watkins, Weise, Gamble and Shantz in favor.

MMS Shantz/Hoffman to adjourn. MC
