A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, ENDORSING THE DEDICATION OF WINTER TRAILS TO PROVIDE WINTER ACCESS BETWEEN VILLAGES, PUBLIC LAND, AND RESOURCES.

WHEREAS, the Napakiak Corporation has filed on certain lands under the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act; and


WHEREAS, a portion of those lands have been used as a winter trail by the general public for several years; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has filed an appeal with the U.S. Department of Interior Alaska Native Claims Appeal Board to have the existing trail deleted from the Napakiak Corporation Selections and reserved as a Public Easement,


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Bethel, Alaska, that the City of Bethel endorses the dedication of a winter trail as specified by the State of Alaska appeal on Napakiak Corporation selected lands to be reserved as a Public Easement.
