A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA, REQUESTING FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION, FOR THE RIVERBANK STABILIZATION PROGRAM AND DOCK FACILITY,

WHEREAS, the Alaska State Legislature has appropriated \$1,438,000.00 to the City of Bethel for the riverbank stabilization program and dock facility; and

WHEREAS, erosion along the riverbank at Bethel poses a serious and dangerous threat to the businesses of Bethel and the residents that work and live near the river; and


WHEREAS, a stable riverbank and adequate dock facility will greatly enhance the commercial and residential use of the river frontage at Bethel,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, supports the request for an appropriation of \$1,438,000 from the State of Alaska, Department of Administration, to the City of Bethel for the riverbank stabilization program and dock facility.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Administration is authorized to act on behalf of the City Council as Council's representative in accepting and implementing the grant award.
