M/M Nicholson, Swanson to remove that section of the sea-wall that is decaying.
Poll vote 4 yes 1 no, Motion Passed.

M/M Crow, Hoffman that the item of City Policeman be moved to the first position on the agenda. Passed

CITY POLICEMAN:

Discussion was held at length on the City police situation.

M/M Crow, Haroldsen that George Dull be offered the contract under the same terms as the previous applicant and that the applicant be telephoned this offer.

M/M Hoffman, Laroux that the raise be effective August 15. Motion passed 5-1 in favor
