A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, SUBMITTING THE CITY OF BETHEL'S TRANSPORTATION PROJECT PRIORITIES TO THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel is committed to achieving the best possible road system to serve the city's residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, adequate transportation facilities are essential for residents' quality of life, expanding commerce, developing resources, and a healthier environment; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, in compliance with the Federal Highway funding in the Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA) seeks to serve the needs of local communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council hereby submits the following projects for inclusion in the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities Needs and Priorities List for the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program:


1. 4th Avenue
2. Main Street, between 3rd and 7th Avenues
3. 7th Avenue
4. Willow Street
5. Atsaq Street (2nd Road, Housing)
6. Separated pathway from Airport to City Center

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Bethel will accept maintenance responsibility for the roads listed above upon completion of each improvement project.
