

RESOLUTION #412

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATION TO NEGOTIATE AND SECURE FINANCING FOR THE PURCHASE OF A FACILITY AND LAND TO OPERATE AND MAINTAIN A BUS PROGRAM FOR THE CITY OF BETHEL.

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel has accepted an implementation plan entitled Transit Market Study prepared by Wright-Forseen and Associates; and

WHEREAS, the study states that garage facilities are required to implement the plan; and

WHEREAS, the study also states that the City's own public works garage should not be used; and


WHEREAS, \$160,000.00 is required to purchase an existing facility that has been constructed especially for the existing bus program; and

WHEREAS, this facility and land is owned by Hustlebuggy, Inc.; and


WHEREAS, Hustlebuggy, Inc. has indicated a willingness to sell said facility and land to the City of Bethel for the bus program,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that the City Council authorizes the City Administration to negotiate and secure financing for the purchase of the facilities and land necessary to operate and maintain a bus program for the City of Bethel.
