A RESOLUTION OF THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL SUPPORTING THE BETHEL FIRE DEPARTMENT IN THEIR EFFORTS TO WORK IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE YUKON KUSKOKWIM HEALTH CORPORATION (YKHC) IN SEEKING GRANT MONIES FOR PHASE III OF THE CODE BLUE PROJECT

WHEREAS, In conjunction with the Yukon Kuskokwim Health Corporation, the Bethel Fire Department has identified available grant monies from the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), and;

WHEREAS, The available grant monies would be used to fund Phase III of the Code Blue Project, providing for additional lifesaving tools, and;


WHEREAS, This portion of the funding requires YKHC, as the regional Emergency Medical Office, to apply for funding on the City of Bethel's behalf, and;

WHEREAS, The total amount of funding requested by the City of Bethel is \$63,985, it is anticipated that \$39,100 is to be received from the Denali Commission, this money will be used to upgrade the EMS communications infrastructure, and;


WHEREAS, The remaining portion of the requested funding by the City of Bethel is \$24,885.00, this portion of the funding will be used to purchase essential equipment, \$8,710 is anticipated to be funded by the USDA, \$14,931 is anticipated to be funded by the State of Alaska and the anticipated local match for the City of Bethel's is \$1,244.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Bethel City Council supports the efforts of the Bethel Fire Department and directs Administration to prepare a budget modification with the General Fund balance as the source of the required City of Bethel local cash match.
