A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING ORUTSARARMIUT NATIVE COUNCIL (ONC) IN REQUESTING BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS (BIA) ROAD FUNDING TO PAVE ATSAQ STREET, DELAPP STREET, MALLARD STREET, AND OWL STREET, AND AGREEING TO PROVIDE FOR MAINTENANCE ONCE THIS ROADS PROJECT IS CONSTRUCTED

Whereas, A resolution supporting Orutsararmiut Native Council (ONC) in requesting Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) road funding to pave Atsaq Street, Delapp Street, Mallard Street, and Owl Street and agreeing to provide for maintenance if the road project is funded, and;

Whereas, ONC is a federally recognized tribe and qualifies for services and benefits under both the Indian Reservation roads and road maintenance programs, and;

Whereas, ONC and the City of Bethel desire to partner to meet the streets and roads needs of the community, and;


Whereas, the City is responsible for streets and roads in the community of Bethel, and is already responsible for maintenance of the roads proposed in ONC's application for funding, and;

Whereas, Paving these roads would alleviate dust, which is of great concern to the community, would improve the safety of traveling, and would improve access for residents of these neighborhoods.

Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved that the City of Bethel, City Council, supports ONC's efforts to secure funding to pave four roads in the Bethel community and supports a partnership between the City of Bethel and ONC to improve streets and roads for the community of Bethel.


