

RESOLUTION 451

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA PROVIDING FOR THE RE-ESTABLISHMENT OF COUNCIL COMMITTEES AND ADOPTING COMMITTEE PROCEDURES THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City Council and the City Manager are engaged in the administration and management of public services for the residents of Bethel, Alaska; and

WHEREAS, such public services are provided to all residents of the City of Bethel, and

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon elected and appointed officials to represent the citizenry and to provide for that citizenry the opportunity to present its concerns to the officials of the community.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of Bethel, Alaska establishes the following Council Standing Committees:

- 1) Finance Committee
- 2) Transportation Committee
- 3) Public Safety Committee
- 4) Public Works Committee
- 5) Community Services Committee


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above established committees shall adopt the following procedures:

- 1) the establishment of a regularly scheduled monthly meeting to be held in the evenings
- 2) the publication of an agenda in three public places seven (7) days before the scheduled meeting
- 3) the adoption of a meeting format which provides for the orderly conduct of committee business
- 4) the appointment of committee members by the Mayor with the concurrence of City Council
- 5) the establishment of a committee membership no less than five (5) nor greater than seven (7) members
- 6) the submission to Council, at the next regularly scheduled Council meeting, a summary of committee recommendations and actions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the purpose of Standing Council Committees shall be:

- 1) to advise Council
- 2) to receive comments and concerns from the public
- 3) to investigate special issues at the direction of Council.
