

RESOLUTION #318

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL, CITY OF BETHEL, ALASKA,  
APPOINTING THE CITY CLERK TO PLACE ON SEPERATE BALLOTS  
DURING THE NEXT GENERAL ELECTION THE CITY'S LIQUOR OPTION.

WHEREAS, the residents of the City of Bethel have presented  
to the Bethel City Council at its regularly scheduled  
Council meeting of September 17, 1980, two (2) petitions  
with regard to the sale of alcohol through a community  
owned liquor store, and a petition supporting prohibition  
of sale and importation of alcoholic beverages; and

WHEREAS, the City has reviewed said petition as presented,  
and;

WHEREAS, the City Clerk has determined that the state  
requirements have been met in accordance with Title  
4. Section 4.11.502, and contains \_\_\_\_\_ of qualified  
registered voters, and;

WHEREAS, The City Council hereby directs the City Clerk  
to place on seperate ballots at the next regular  
election the following propositions:

"Shall the sale and importation of alcoholic beverages  
be prohibited in the City of Bethel: (Yes or No)."

"Shall the sale of alcoholic beverages be prohibited in  
the City of Bethel unless sold by the package store  
operated under a community liquor store? (Yes or No)."

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF BETHEL directing the City Clerk to place before the voters  
at the next regular election local option for sale of alcohol  
and prohibition on sale and importation of alcoholic beverages.
