## RESOLUTION #96-39

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL DECLARING THE AREAS AROUND ALL BETHEL SCHOOLS, THE BETHEL YOUTH CENTER, AND THE LOG CABIN, AS "DRUG AND ALCOHOL-FREE ZONES" IN ACCORDANCE WITH A.S. 28.01.010.**

**WHEREAS**, the citizens of Bethel want to provide their children with education and recreational activities conducted in drug and alcohol free environments; and

**WHEREAS**, Alaska Statutes 28 01.010(d)1 states that a municipality shall post a sign indicating that the school is a "drug-free school zone" at each location in which it has installed a sign identifying the location of a school; and

**WHEREAS**, Alaska Statutes 28 01 010(d)2 states that a municipality may post a sign at each recreation and youth center indicating that the center is a "drug-free recreation and youth center zone."

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of Bethel, Alaska hereby declares the areas immediately adjacent to the Bethel Regional High School, Mikelnguut Elitnaurviat School, Involved Parent's Preschool, AVCP Headstart School, LKSD Preschool, and Kilbuck Elementary School as "Drug and Alcohol-Free School Zones," and the areas immediately adjacent to the Bethel Youth Center and Log Cabin as "Drug and Alcohol-Free Recreation and Youth Center Zones"

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Council directs the City Manager to obtain and erect signs indicating the Drug and Alcohol-Free Zones as described herein.
