## CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

FEBRUARY 4, 1982

MEETING TO ORDER                   The Special Meeting of the Bethel City Council was called to order by Mayor Guinn at 7.35 pm.

ROLL CALL                           Present: Guinn, Twitchell, Anvil, Carpenter, Pavil, Binkley.  
Absent: B. Hoffman.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES               No minutes.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA               M/M by Twitchell, 2nd by Anvil to accept the agenda as presented. Voice vote taken, motion carried.

MANAGER'S REPORT                 City Manager Hoffman reported that the Special Meeting of the City Council was called in order to finalize a Legislative priority list for the State Legislature. The priorities should be before the Legislature by February 9. Nancy Kraning is in Juneau the week of February 4 to meet with the Legislators concerning three of Bethel funding needs: Riverbank erosion, a recreation facility and road repair.

  Dan Boyette, Capital Projects Director, reviewed the list of projects for presentation to the Legislature.

NEW BUSINESS                       Public Hearing on Legislative priorities. The Public Hearing was opened at 8 pm. by Mayor Guinn. Concerns expressed by the public at the hearing included:

- a. operational and maintenance costs for the buildings once completed;
- b. did the City have adequate information for the Legislature with respect to yearly upkeep costs;
- c. the order of the priority list;
- d. the effect of reduced federal and state funds on completion and maintenance of the facilities;
- e. the dollar amounts requested, those amounts being perhaps too large in total - suggestion that projects should be phased to reduce the amount requested for this year.

  M/M by Carpenter, 2nd by Twitchell to accept the priority list as presented. No vote taken. Mayor Guinn called for a 10 minute recess at 8.38. Meeting resumed at 8.48 pm. After reconvening, Council presented a revised priority list for Legislative consideration. Councilmember Carpenter withdrew her motion to accept

the legislative priority list as originally presented. Councilmember Twitchell withdrew his 2nd of that motion.

M/M by Carpenter, 2nd by Pavil to accept the amended legislative priority list for presentation to the State Legislature. Voice vote was taken, motion carried. Total cost for the priorities listed for presentation to the State Legislature was \$16,858,004.00, the break-out as follows:


a. Riverbank Erosion Control	\$ 5,763,625.00
b. Recreation Center	5,200,000.00
c. Centennial Center	4,900,000.00
d. Mini-parks (first of three)	30,000.00
e. Bethel Roads	289,915.00
f. Bethel Highway Parking Shoulder	324,464.00
g. Juvenile Detention Center	<u>350,000.00</u>
Total -	\$16,858,004.00

The following items were supported by Resolution:

- a. Kisaralik Hydro project
- b. Airport runway repair
- c. KCC dormitories
- d. Bethel - Napakiak Road
- e. Alaska Legal Services
