

RESOLUTION #411

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS PERFORMED BY THE STATE OF ALASKA, DOTPF, WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF BETHEL, ALASKA.

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, DOTPF, has received \$7.7 million from the 1983 Alaska State Legislature to be used for upgrading the Bethel Airport; and

WHEREAS, there will be a surplus of funds following the award of the construction contracts and additional change orders for the above mentioned project; and

WHEREAS, the funds appropriated are earmarked for transportation projects in Bethel; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska owns and the City of Bethel operates a Medium Draft Port in Bethel, Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the Bethel Medium Draft Port is in need of many and various improvements, including land acquisition for staging area expansion, re-surfacing, warehouse construction, security fencing, two additional cells, and improved lighting,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that any funds remaining in the \$7.7 million appropriation after the award of construction contracts for the Bethel Airport improvements be re-programmed for improvements to the Bethel Medium Draft Port.
