

MINUTES OF BETHEL COUNCIL MEETING
COUNCIL HUP - August 5, 1958

Meeting called to order at 1:30 p.m. by Chairman, Elliott.

Elliott made a motion that the Village Council start accepting applications for a City Policeman for the Village of Bethel, with duties open for further consideration. Wages at \$500.00 per month with the title of Chief of Police for the Village of Bethel with the power to enforce Village Ordinances as passed by the Council. Applicants have to be at least 21 years of age and able to read and write the English Language. Duties and responsibilities can be changed by the Village Council.

Miller seconded the motion.

Votes: All ayes. No nays.

Motion passed.

Chamber of Commerce asked to take pictures of Village Council. Miller said his equipment was available.

Suggestion was made that the Department of Health might give the Village Council the use of their office.

Motion made by Elliott that Lots 1 and 23, if there are no objections by the Department of Education, be turned over to ADH for their Health Center and that Resolution No. 2 be changed accordingly.

Hoffman seconded the motion.

Votes: All Ayes. No nays.

Motion passed.

Motion made by Miller that 1st reading of Curfew be drawn up and read at the next Council Meeting, August 12.

Elliott seconded the motion.

Motion passed.

Elliott suggested the nomination of future candidates for Village Council would be held at the Meeting Aug. 12, 1958, also reading of other Village Ordinances.
