

RESOLUTION #608

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BETHEL, ALASKA, AUTHORIZING THE NAME CHANGE OF THE BETHEL SENIOR CENTER TO "THE EDDIE HOFFMAN SENIOR CENTER."

WHEREAS, Edward Hoffman Sr. has served the people of the Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta by establishing several organizations and serving on numerous boards, including founder, Chairman, and the lifetime Traditional Chief of the Association of Village Council Presidents, Presidents of the Bethel Native Corporation, Calista Board Member, Bethel Broadcasting Board Member, and Chairman of the Orutsararmuit Native Council. He also served on the Boards of Directors of Yugtak Corporation, Yukon-Kuskokwim Health Corporation, and Kuskokwim Valley Native Association.

WHEREAS, Eddie recognized a need to get involved in decision-making for the community and delta, and

WHEREAS, Chief Hoffman will always be remembered as a staunch defender of Native rights;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Bethel City Council, in recognition of Edward Hoffman Sr.'s dedication to the people of Bethel and the delta, do hereby change the name of the Bethel Senior Center to "The Eddie Hoffman Senior Center."
