ORDINANCE #00-26

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN CHAPTERS IN THE BETHEL MUNICIPAL CODE TO INCLUDE AS A PREREQUISITE TO OBTAINING A BUSINESS LICENSE AND/OR PROCUREMENT CONTRACT THAT AMOUNTS DUE TO THE CITY BE PAID

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska, that:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is permanent in nature and shall be placed in the Bethel Municipal Code.

Section 2. Amendment of Chapter 4.20. Chapter 4.20 of the Bethel Municipal Code is amended to add the following section (new language is underlined):

Chapter 4.20 Purchasing

4.20.290 Contractor in Good Standing

No procurement contract may be awarded to a person, group, organization, or other entity that is delinquent in the payment or collection of sales taxes, fees, charges, penalties, interest or other amounts that are due and owing, or otherwise obligated to the City.

Section 3. Amendment of Section 5.04.020 Section 5.04.020 of the Bethel Municipal Code is amended as follows (new language is underlined and old language is stricken out):

5.04.020 Other regulatory provisions

A person engaging in a business ~~subject to licensing provisions of a regulatory nature~~ must, unless determined otherwise for good cause by the finance director, in addition to filing the regular application required by this chapter, be current on payment and collection of sales taxes, port fees, and any and all other payments, fees, taxes, charges, penalties, interest, and/or other amounts that are due and owing and/or obligated to the City, and comply with any other regulatory

provisions before being entitled to a license. The finance director shall not issue or renew a business license to a person who is not in compliance with this section.

Section 4. Amendment of Section 5.04.070 Section 5.04.070 of the Bethel Municipal Code is amended as follows (new language is underlined and old language is stricken out):

5.04.070 Regulations.

The ~~city clerk~~ finance director may, with the approval of the city council, promulgate regulations necessary to determine and collect fees imposed and to otherwise enforce the provisions of this chapter.

Section 5. Amendment of Section 5.04.110 Section 5.04.110E of the Bethel Municipal Code is amended as follows (new language is underlined and old language is stricken out):

5.04.110 Offenses


It is unlawful for a person to:


E. Fail to pay the required licensing fee, sales taxes, port fees, and any and all other payments, fees, taxes, charges, penalties, interest, and/or other amounts that are due and owing to the City.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately.
