A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BETHEL TO PARTICIPATE IN PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE PROJECT # AN-89-010.

WHEREAS, the Bethel City Council, hereinafter called the Council, is the governing body of Bethel, Alaska; and

WHEREAS, said Council is desirous of aiding the Indian Health Service, hereinafter called the IHS, in providing adequate sanitation facilities for the residents of Bethel; and


WHEREAS, said Council has authorized the City Manager to represent it in matters concerning sanitation facilities development.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that said Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into agreement upon Council approval with the IHS on behalf of City concerning the provisions and transfer of sanitation facilities for Bethel, Alaska.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said Council will cooperate with the provisions of any agreement entered into by the Council's representation and the IHS, and they will be duly carried out.


