There are some snow machine markers around town and would like to see some put up. Would like to write a letter to Joerene Hout and have here address this to the council.


C. Mary Gregory - Resign

X. ADJOURNMENT


Carl Berger/Allen Glore move to adjourn at 7:55p.m. Motion carried unanimously.
