

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE MINUTES

October 21, 1992
1200 hrs.

Police Department

The meeting was called to order at 1210 hrs. by Chairman Abrant.

Roll Call: Gary Vanasse, John Abrant, Susan Rapoza, Chief Chris Liu, and George Young.
Quorum Present.

Approval of Minutes: The Committee is not in possession of the minutes.

M/M by Vanasse, 2nd by Rapoza to table the approval of the meeting minutes until the next regular scheduled meeting. Motion passed unanimously.

M/M by Vanasse, 2nd by Rapoza to approve the agenda. Motion passed unanimously.

Public Safety Committee Member Comments:

Clarification was made about the City Council awarding the use of the old Bojangles building to the Pacifica Institute. BYSP did in the past submit a request to use the building to the previous City Manager, although it has not been addressed. Chief Liu feels it is not in the best interest of the City to revisit the issue.

Mr. Vanasse expressed genuine interest in working with the PSC and looks forward to the important role the Committee can have in the future.

The Citizen's Review Board's role was discussed, and Chief Liu concurs with the board's outcome.

Chief Liu requested the PSC endorse his recent recommendation to delete the vacant Police Officer's position, and add two Community Service Officer positions in place of it.

M/M by Vanasse, 2nd by Abrant to endorse the recommendation to delete the vacant Police Officer's position and add two Community Service Officer positions. Motion Passed Unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

Item A: Use of Fireworks

Chief Liu would like to abolish the use in the City. We can readdress the issue in the summer.

Item B: Policy on Disposal of Deceased Animals

The policy is in place, it complies with State law. Public Works has provided salted dirt for the winter months.

Item C: Draft Ordinance on Curfew Hours

Recommended that the Ordinance have curfew hours for minors under the age of eighteen (18) due to the increase in crimes involving juveniles.

M/M by Rapoza, 2nd by Abrant to amend ordinance number 9 for curfew hours. Motion passes, Vanasse stated he may have conflict being on the City Council.
