No. 2 Should the City of Bethel support a liquor license application for a bar within the City of Bethel? A majority of the voters voted NO.


No. 3 Should the City of Bethel support a liquor license application for a restaurant or eating establishment within the City of Bethel? A majority of the voters voted NO.


No. 4 Should the City of Bethel support a liquor license application for a club license within the City of Bethel? A majority of the voters voted NO.
