Park development while important is sometimes difficult to fund by governments with all of the necessary services being so costly. Even with the current fiscal challenges, the Bethel City Council find importance in investing in our community's public areas to help promote healthy activity and community togetherness.

One area that is in need of a public park and playground is Kasauli Subdivision. The most outlying subdivision in town, Kasauli is over five miles from the closest park.

While funding may be an initial concern, there are a few grant options that Administration can consider when developing a plan that would help offset the cost of building the park; the Subdivision already has property, owned by the City, dedicated to Recreational Space; and there are many different low maintenance playground options that can be considered for future sustainability.

Administration should bring back to Council an action plan for the development of a park in Kasauli with a goal of park construction in the summer 2018.
