Summary Statement

The City of Bethel worked with its assigned Village Safe Water Program engineer to apply for \$900,000 in grant funding in April 2016 through the Sanitation Deficiency System process to pay for the replacement of the Bethel Main Lift Station and electric panels at five other lift stations. The City received notice from the VSW Program that its project was approved for funding. Cooperative Project Agreement documents will be prepared by late summer-early fall.

The Lift Station to be replaced is located on Akakeek Road, next door to AC Quickstop. Built in 1974-75, the outdated lift station has failed on numerous occasions due to its valves, pumps, and electric panel.

The five lift stations targeted for electric panel replacement are:

1. Bethel Heights East lift station, constructed in 1974-75.
2. Kilbuck lift station on 5th and Main Streets, built in 1974-75.
3. Bethel Heights West lift station on Akula Street, built around 1995.
4. Public Works Building lift station, built around 1995.
5. City Hall lift station, built in 1981.
