In July of this year a Request for Bids was released seeking bids for installation of the main line for the Institutional Corridor. During the time the bid was open, two Addenda were issued. No protests as to form or content of the bid were filed.

Despite 23 companies showing an interest in the project, on the due date of August 8th, there were only three (3) companies that submitted a bid. The bids were all read publicly with people from the public present.

The bids were as follows:
