Adopt a Dumpster Pad Program

Application

The adopt-a-dumpster pad program is a great way to make a difference in our community and bring with it the pride that we should have in Bethel. By adopting a dumpster pad, you can make the community more beautiful while protecting the environment. Churches, individuals, public agencies, companies and corporations are encouraged to adopt-a-dumpster pad for a period of two years. Clean pads discourage the dumping of unwanted items on the ground.

Adopters Responsibilities:

Volunteers agree to keep their site clean. This involves picking up litter on the pad or raking it and shoveling it in the dumpsters, in general keeping the pad free of debris and unsightly clutter.

Volunteers agree to call the Bethel Landfill Office to inform us of any big items that we need to pick up or any other concerns about the site.

Volunteers agree to a two-year adoption of their dumpster pad of choice.

Volunteers agree to clean their site at least once a month.

Cities Responsibilities:

The City workers agree to respond to the needs of the volunteers by picking up large items left on the ground and dealing with other issues that come up concerning the dumpster pad.

The City will provide a metal sign at your dumpster pad that gives recognition to your organization's participation.
