Prizes include:


\$300 – 1st place prize

Route Option C – This option attempts to include as many roads in as many neighborhood as possible (bring the parade to your front porch).

Starts at Small Boat Harbor then does a counterclockwise loop around the city going through: Avenues neighborhood, Bethel Heights, Uiviq Subdivision, Tundra Ridge, then back to Bethel Heights, goes through City Sub, then out towards Blueberry, then Larson Subdivision, then Kasayuli and head back towards Q2/Hoffman Subdivision, 1st Ave neighborhood, then to Front Street to end.

Distance = 25.2 miles (almost a marathon)

Parade Judging Area = Front of Port Office
