

FINAL CONTRACT EXTENSION BULK FUEL AGREEMENT

This contract extension is made this 30th day of June, 2017, by and between the City of Bethel, a municipal corporation (hereinafter "City") and Delta Western (hereinafter "Contractor").

Pursuant to section 19 of the Bulk Fuel Agreement entered into between the parties on December 31, 2014, the Parties agree to the final allowable extension. This extension shall expire on June 30, 2018.

Modification #1:

Section 5 (Prices) of the Bulk Fuel Agreement, is modified as follows:

Heating Oil Delivered: Shall be charged at the rate of \$3.08 (Three Dollars and eight cents) per gallon*

HF#1 Ultra Low Sulfur Diesel (ULSD) Fuel Delivered: Shall be charged at the rate of \$3.08[^] per gallon*

Gasoline at the Pump: Shall be charged at the rate of 0.30¢ per gallon* below the lowest posted price in Bethel, Alaska and will fluctuate with the market.

HF#1 Ultra Low Sulfur Diesel (ULSD) Fuel at the Pump: Shall be billed at the rate of 0.30¢ per gallon* below the lowest posted price in Bethel, Alaska and will fluctuate with the market.

* "Gallon" shall be defined as a U.S. Standard gallon of 231 cubic inches at 60° Fahrenheit

[^] All prices quoted are **maximum** prices. Should competitor prices in Bethel be lower, Delta Western guarantees City will be charged 0.30¢ less than those offered elsewhere in Bethel, Alaska.

Modification #2:

New Provision: The parties agree to add a new provision: Delta Western to require all of its subcontractors to file proof payment of City of Bethel sales tax payments monthly. Delta Western is solely responsible for monitoring compliance with sales tax payments by its chosen subcontractors. Failure of Delta Western or any of its subcontractors to remit timely filing of City sales tax payments is a Breach of the Bulk Fuel Agreement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties have caused this contract extension and modification to be executed, effective July 1, 2017.


