ORDINANCE #11-20

AN ORDINANCE BY THE BETHEL CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF ALL REMAINING MULTI-USE RECREATION CENTER FUNDS IN THE CENTRAL TREASURY TO THE DESIGNATED WELLS FARGO BATH ACCOUNT

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel ("City") levies a sales tax, of which a percentage is intended to fund development of the Bethel Aquatic Training and Health (BATH) Center;

WHEREAS, it is imperative that funds designated for the BATH Center account not be co-mingled with other funding to ensure availability;

WHEREAS, a designated interest bearing account specifically for the BATH Center has already been established;

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of Bethel, Alaska; that:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is permanent in nature and shall not be codified in the Bethel Municipal Code.


SECTION 2. Authorization. Administration is directed by this ordinance to transfer all remaining Multi-Use Recreation Center funds in the Central Treasury of the City to the designated Wells Fargo BATH Account.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage by the City Council.
