A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING VILLAGE SAFE WATER FUNDING FROM DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,000,000 AS PART OF GRANT OFFER #16728

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel wishes to accept Grant Offer #16728 from the State of Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation in the amount of \$3,000,000 as provided for by the Village Safe Water Act (AS46.07);

WHEREAS, this grant will be used to finance construction management and administrative services for service area 1A, and design, construction, construction management and administrative services for service area 1B water and sewer improvements;


WHEREAS, the resulting water and sewer improvements are good for the overall quality of life for the citizens of Bethel.
