ACCEPT AND APPROVE ALASKA'S FY 2012 RURAL TRANSIT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM GRANT TO FUND TRAINING AND TRAVEL OF BETHEL TRANSIT SYSTEM PERSONNEL

WHEREAS, the City of Bethel relies on grant funding to support the training needs of Bethel Transit System personnel;

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, Transit Division, administers Alaska's SFY 2012 Rural Transit Assistance Program (RTAP), a Federal Transit Administration program that provides funds to train transit system personnel;

WHEREAS, there is an on-going need to train the City's transit manager and transit bus drivers in order to meet federal, state, and local requirements and to elevate the level of service capability;


WHEREAS, Bethel City Council approved Resolution #11-07 on March 29, 2011 to pursue FY 2012 RTAP funds;

WHEREAS, the grant amount is \$5,632 with no cash match required from the City;


WHEREAS, the grant performance period is one year, from July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bethel City Council accepts and approves Alaska's SFY 2012 Rural Transit Assistance Program grant that will cover the cost of training and travel for Bethel Transit System personnel.
