A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE KUIMARVIK-A PLACE TO SWIM INC. BYLAWS DATED JULY, 2011, PROVIDE SUPPORT TO THE CREATION OF THE CORPORATION, AND COMMITTING TO THE CITY'S INVOLVEMENT

WHEREAS, Kuimarvik- A Place to Swim Inc. is established to fund-raise and construct an aquatic and fitness center in Bethel to teach water safety, health and fitness and to provide exercise opportunities for Bethel youth and adults and the Yukon Kuskokwim Delta;

WHEREAS, Kuimarvik- A Place to Swim Inc. is currently made up of 12 Directors of the board, consisting of the City Manager of the City of Bethel, CIO/President of the Yukon Kuskokwim Health Corporation, Director of the University of Alaska Fairbanks, Kuskokwim Campus, Executive Director of Yuut Elinaurviat-People's Learning Center, Superintendent of Lower Kuskokwim School District, Executive Director of ONC, President of Association of Village Council Presidents, Inc., President of the Association of Village Council Presidents, Regional Housing Authority, Captain of the Alaska National Guard, Bethel, Superintendent of the Iditarod School District, and CEO of Calista Corporation;

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2011, the Directors of Kuimarvik- A Place to Swim, voted to approve the Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws;

WHEREAS, the Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws are being disseminated for approval to the participating organizations to insure all parties involved are in support of the corporation and will provide the ongoing commitment necessary to carry out the goal of construction;

WHEREAS, the Articles outlines in the bylaws consist of, the Corporation; Board of Directors; Officers and Employees of the Corporation; Meetings; Committees; Contracts and Fiscal Activities; Books and Records;

WHEREAS, the Bethel City Council fully supports creating the Corporation, believing that the organizations forming the corporation will work together diligently through the construction of a swimming facility;
